



PCNC REGISTRATION PROCESS AND CONDITIONS POLICY

1. Purpose

To provide players with the opportunity to represent Pohutukawa Coast Netball Club Incorporated (PCNC) at a level suitable to their ability, and in accordance with the values and strategic vision of the club.

2. Registration

All players must register online via the links provided on the PCNC website and social media pages. The open and closing dates will also be made available on the PCNC website and social media pages. Payment must be made in full by Direct Credit into the PCNC bank account as noted on the registration form. Registration payments must not include payments for Uniforms.

The PCNC Code of Conduct must be read and adhered to by all players and supporters. The PCNC Selection Policy should be read by all players/guardians. When a Registration Form has been completed, this is an acknowledgement that parents and players have read and understood this document as well as the PCNC Code of Conduct and Selection Policy documents.

3. Junior/College

Junior and College players must have registered and paid their registration fee by the final registration/payment date noted above and on the registration form. Registrations may be deleted prior to trials if payment has not been made. This means that even if your child is registered, if her fee is unpaid she may not be eligible to trial.

Late registrations, or players that have registered but not paid their fees, will only be considered if the club needs additional players to make up a team, plus they will be allocated to the lowest team level unless specifically requested otherwise by the Head Selector.

Registration fees are non-refundable, unless the player incurs an injury during PCNC netball practice, prior to the first HPNC game of the season that prohibits them from being able to further participate in the season. This may also be subject to a new replacement player being found.

College players registered and selected in a Senior team are expected to pay Senior registration fees.

4. Senior

Some negotiated flexibility is afforded to some Senior competitive players who may be permitted to trial prior to having paid their registration fee. We do however ask that they have registered online by the registration date to acknowledge their interest and to enable us to communicate trial dates and information to them. We will require payment of fees within 3 days of the team announcements for these players. Preferably all registration fees for Senior players are paid prior to trials. This helps the treasurer and registration delegate enormously.

Seniors selected in the competitive PCNC teams are required to pay a surcharge of \$30 per player within 14 days of team naming.

5. Playing Up

Saturday netball at Howick Pakuranga Netball Club is available to all girls in school Year 5 or above. While “playing up” is possible (eg. a Year 6 girl plays in a Year 7 team), this is only considered if there are too many of a lower year group and/or not enough of a higher year group. Note: this does not include playing up during the season, if a higher team is occasionally short of players. If this is required, a player can only play up twice – the third time means they must join that team and leave their lower team.
